SECRETARY REPORT - Dina O'Sullivan

- Mulch completed last week.
- Spring McCloud needle life on the front berm
 - o Algae treatment only completed on the south side
 - o The North side treatment will be completed next week
- 3 bids were presented to the board for the front berm dead trees to be removed
 - Kim made the motion to use the vendor Endover and not to exceed \$995.00 and Mark second the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- CamVac will come out once the weather is better for scoping and jetting Anthony managing this situation.

- Anthony will contact Bruce Aderman to discuss drainage issue from main pond to Fox Mill. There is sediment in our pond and going up because it's not draining properly.
- A dead willow tree by the main pond needs to be removed. Jack received two out of the
 three bids due to one of the vendors still on vacation. Dina made the motion to have
 Jack negotiate removing the stump grind and remove the entire willow tree for no more
 than \$1200.00. Mark second motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Waiting for Bruce Aderman to look at the main pond overflow before ACHA makes any final decisions with next steps.
 - Endevor said they would cut the weeds and clean out the garbage, but not spray for \$95.00.
- Need to discuss replacing the trees that need to be removed on the 64 berm. Kim will
 add this topic to the agenda for next month's meeting. There are approximately 9 trees
 that might need to be replaced.
- The landscaping procedures are available on the ACHA website.

NEW BUSINESS – Kim Stephen
